MATERIAL LIST - BRIAN STEWART'S INDOOR PLEIN AIR WORKSHOP

PAINT- I use Utrecht paints and lay them out on a *clean* pallet in this order:

Titanium White (Windsor Newton)
Cad Lemon Yellow
Cad Yellow Light
Cad Orange
Cad Red
Alizarin Crimson
French Ultra Marine Blue
Ivory Black
Transparent Oxide Brown (Rembrandt)

BRUSHES

10, 8, 6, 5, 4, Filberts. Robert Simmons is a good brand.

THINNER

Terpenoid Oderless Thinner or Walnut Oil with containers that attach to the pallet or are secured in some way so they don't tip.

PAPER TOWELS

Viva, soft absorbent select-a-size towels. Plastic bag for soiled towels

CANVAS PANELS

Small, inexpensive 6x8s, 8x10s or 9x12s Fredericks panels will work for a workshop.

VIEW FINDER

Cardboard with a hole cut in it the same proportions as the panels you are using with crosshairs strung across the center. The hole is 3×4 or slightly smaller if you are painting on a 9×12 panel.

PORTABLE EASEL

A French Easel or an Open Box M are good.
